



2020 Palouse Prairie Foundation Membership Letter

PRESERVE-PROTECT-PROMOTE

Why should you support the Palouse Prairie Foundation with your 2020 membership?

In 2019, the Palouse Prairie Foundation:

- Controlled weeds at Whelan Cemetery through volunteer efforts of Eric Anderson (pulling weeds every weekend from April to August!) and the PPF Annual Weeding Party; supported the Palouse Conservation District in planting a peripheral weed-suppression buffer and removing encroaching lilac bushes.
- Sprayed the John Crock Native Plant and Pollinator Garden site on the Latah Trail (next to Lenville Road) during the summer for weeds; planted native grass seed this fall; mulched the site to promote germination.
- Approved a \$1000 grant to the Appaloosa Horse Museum for the establishment of a native plant garden.
- Co-sponsored public presentations with the White Pine Chapter of the Idaho Native Plant Society including a workshop and field trip led by Pam Brunsfeld to identify the native species at Whelan Cemetery.
- Provided legal protection for the Palouse Prairie through formal county commissioner approval of the Whitman County Critical Areas Ordinance; development will not be approved if Palouse Prairie is impacted. Provided the Whitman County Known and Potential Palouse Prairie site map.
- Provided legal protection of the Palouse Prairie by adoption into the City of Pullman Critical Areas Ordinance. Provided the Whitman County Known and Potential Palouse Prairie site map.
- Verified that Latah County has planning documents that recognize and protect Palouse Prairie and uses the Latah County Known and Potential Palouse Prairie site map.
